Church Retreat

We thank God for a wonderful weekend away as a church family last month. Many of you have fed back to us about the numerous fine aspects to it, including a superb Saturday night bonfire and entertainment, great sports together, fantastic child care, and most of all Pastor Jimmy's words to us on "Growing as a Gospel Centred Community", based on Paul's letter to the Philippians.

There were many indications of God mightily at work among us.

We're also grateful to all the people who played their part in making the weekend such a success.

As Paul Louis Metzger writes in his book "God's New Humanity" (which Jimmy recently recommended to me), "God builds the new community of Pentecost on the ancient ruins of Babel". In other words, he builds his church which reflects his love to the needy world around us on our new patient, selfless love for one another, that we have when we become Christians, as opposed to our own old attempts at making a name for ourselves that predominated in us before we were believers. As we've seen in recent Sundays, John 17:23 makes clear that the world will know that God sent his Son when we live in the unity that is flowing from the love of God who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. And in which we participate when we are part of God's new humanity in union with Jesus Christ.

The weekend away was a great help in thinking through some implications of this. For example, one of the key teachings was how Paul refers 10 times in the letter to the vital importance of the likemindedness, or one mindedness of Christian believers; that the secret of a healthy happy church, one that is growing especially in reaching lost people and making them disciples, is that it is a church that is together, having the same focus and vision, all going in the same direction.

And therefore much of the practical teaching was about the humility, gentleness, servant-hearted love and prayerfulness that makes this happen. Now is the time to continue to pray and grow and love one another into living this out! God bless you as you join us in our being and growing as a gospel centred community, a community of God's new humanity among the nations in Bremen!
